ARTICLE IV. MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. There shall be two types of membership levels within HESA.

Section 1.1 Non-voting membership is open to all graduate or professional students currently enrolled at The University of Alabama.

Section 1.2 Voting membership is open to students who are currently enrolled in the Higher Education Administration program (all degree levels) and who have paid annual dues.

Section 2. Membership in HESA shall be open to all Higher Education Administration students at The University of Alabama, regardless of genetic or family medical history information, race, color, religion, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression, pregnancy, age, disability, protected veteran status or any other legally protected basis.

I. MEMBERSHIP

- A. Voting membership dues shall be \$20 per year.
- B. Dues shall be paid by the beginning of the **first** regular meeting of the spring semester via cash or check.
- C. Members who have not paid their dues by the due date shall be considered as non-voting members.
- D. Occasionally HESA may need to assess a fee or collect money from the membership for special events/purposes. The amount of money collected shall be determined by a majority of the voting membership at a regularly scheduled meeting.
- E. HESA funds shall not be used to purchase or reimburse members for alcoholic beverages.

Dues Deadline: February 13 Ballots Sent: February 20



D. Elections

- 1. Elections will be based on self-nominations for officer positions.
- Nominations shall be due electronically one week after the first meeting of the spring semester.
- 3. Candidates may run for multiple offices.
- Voting for new officers will occur by an electronic ballot two weeks after the first meeting of the spring semester, administered by the HESA advisor.
- 5. New officers will be announced at the second meeting of spring semester.
- New officers will be sworn in at the last meeting of the spring semester, even if not present.

ARTICLE V. OFFICERS

Section 1. The officers of HESA shall be President, Vice President of Administration (Vice President), Vice President of Programming (Treasurer), and Vice President of External Relations (Secretary). These officers must be voting members and shall comprise the Executive Board.

Section 2. Executive Board nominations shall be due one week after the first meeting of the spring semester and officers will be sworn in at the last meeting of the spring semester.

Section 3. Elections shall be by secret ballot. Candidates receiving a simple majority of the total number of votes shall be named to their respective offices.

Section 4. Officers shall be elected to serve for one year, beginning at the close of the last meeting of the spring semester.

Section 5. Officers may be removed by the advisor if no longer in good academic or disciplinary standing at The University of Alabama.

Section 6. Vacancies in offices may be filled by nomination from any HESA member and election by voting members.
